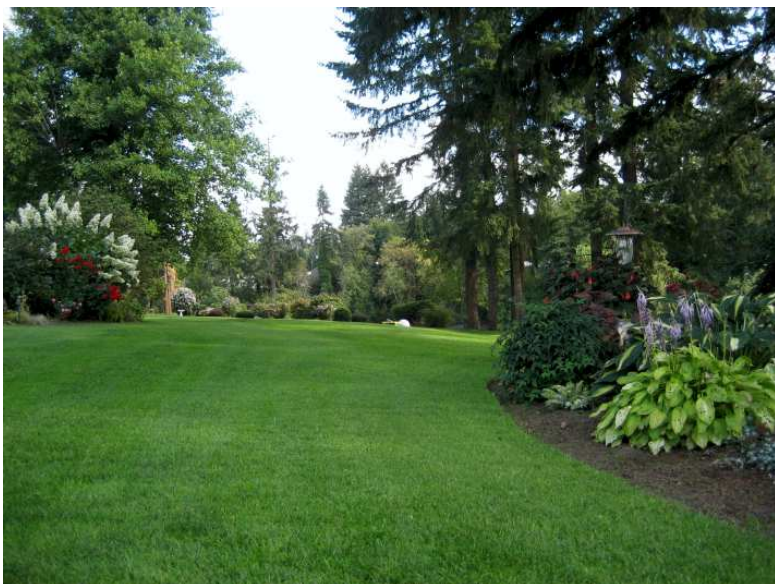


BANFIELD

QUICK FACTS: *Banfield* (IS-PR 491) is a versatile perennial ryegrass with the highest marks for overall turf quality. According to recent data from the 2010 Perennial Ryegrass NTEP, 75% of the time *Banfield* is in the top 25% of all entries across all trials - the highest score given. *Banfield* is wear tolerant, gray leaf spot and brown patch resistant, and demonstrates very good recovery from drought.

ADAPTATION: *Banfield* was developed for permanent turf as a straight or in blends, and mixtures where perennial ryegrass is an acceptable component. Very versatile with excellent wear tolerance, *Banfield* is designed for use in parks, sports fields and other professional venues. It's well suited for southern locations and the transition zone.

SEEDING RATE: 7-10 lbs. p/1000 sq. ft.
